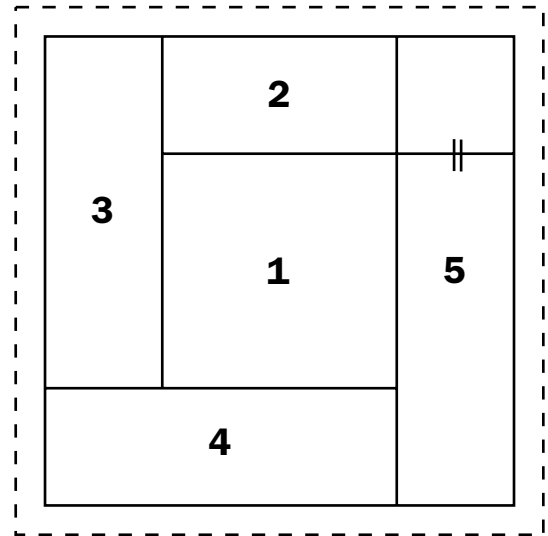
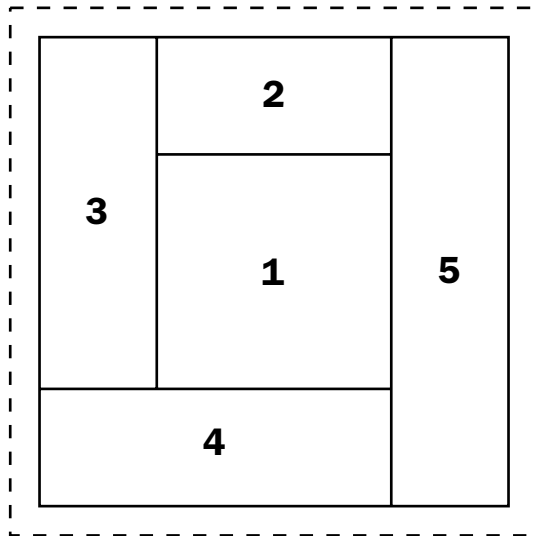
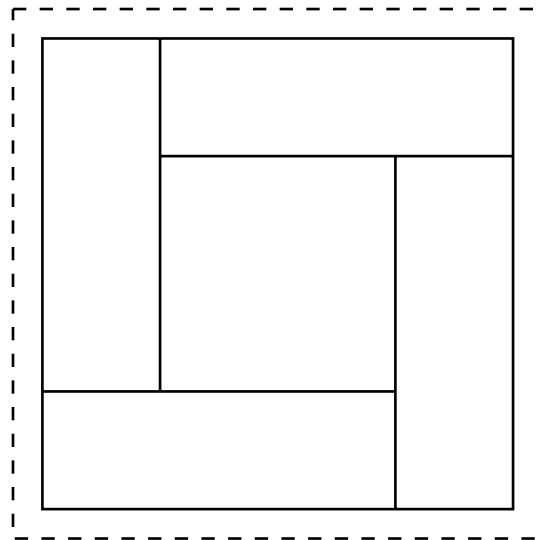


# Designing Your Own Paper Piecing Patterns

## Part 2: Adapting a Pattern for Paper Piecing

Here's a block you can't paper piece.



Change one line, and you can paper piece it. See the line between patch #1 and #2? That's why you can paper piece this one, but not the previous block.

But, it didn't match our original pattern. That top right corner needs to be the same fabric is patch #2. So, your first step in making your block is to piece together patch #5. That's what the double lines signify. Then use it in turn, matching the seams to get your corner.
